Randall M. Knight Memorial Scholarship

The CSBA, Inc. has established a scholarship in memory of Randall M. Knight. In keeping with our mission statement “to promote and encourage the keeping of sheep in Connecticut” the scholarship may give preference to students who are pursuing a career in the agriculture industry. The winning candidate will receive \$500. To qualify individuals must:

- a. Be a resident of Connecticut and be enrolled as a college undergraduate or enrolled in a vocational program during the 2017-2018 school year.
- b. Be or have recently been involved in some aspect of sheep or wool production.
- c. Additional preference may be given to members or children of members of the Connecticut Sheep Breeders Association who have held membership for 3 or more years.
- d. Applicants may reapply in successive years as long as they meet scholarship criteria.
